# WELCOME BACK TO THE LABRUM SCHOOL!

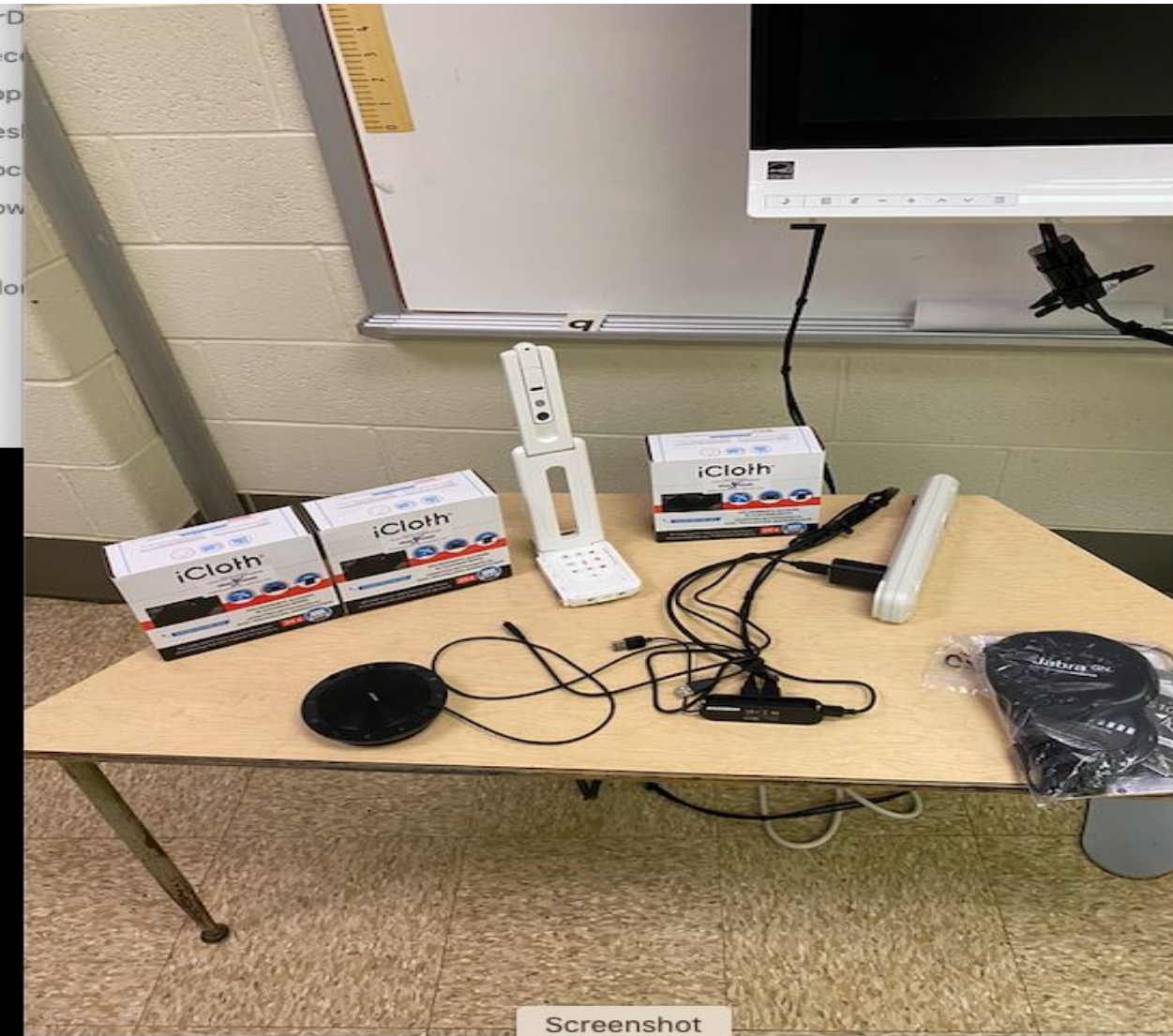


Our classrooms are cleaned and organized for safe in-person/hybrid learning.

# Where does my child enter?

## Arrival - 8:30 AM

- Students in Grades 6 and 7 will arrive at the front of the building and enter through the “Main Entrance” doors. They will proceed directly to their first period class.
- Students in Grade 8 will arrive at the front of the building and enter through the “B” hallway/doors closer to the Gym. They will proceed directly to their first period class.
- Students are not permitted to enter the building until 8:30 AM.



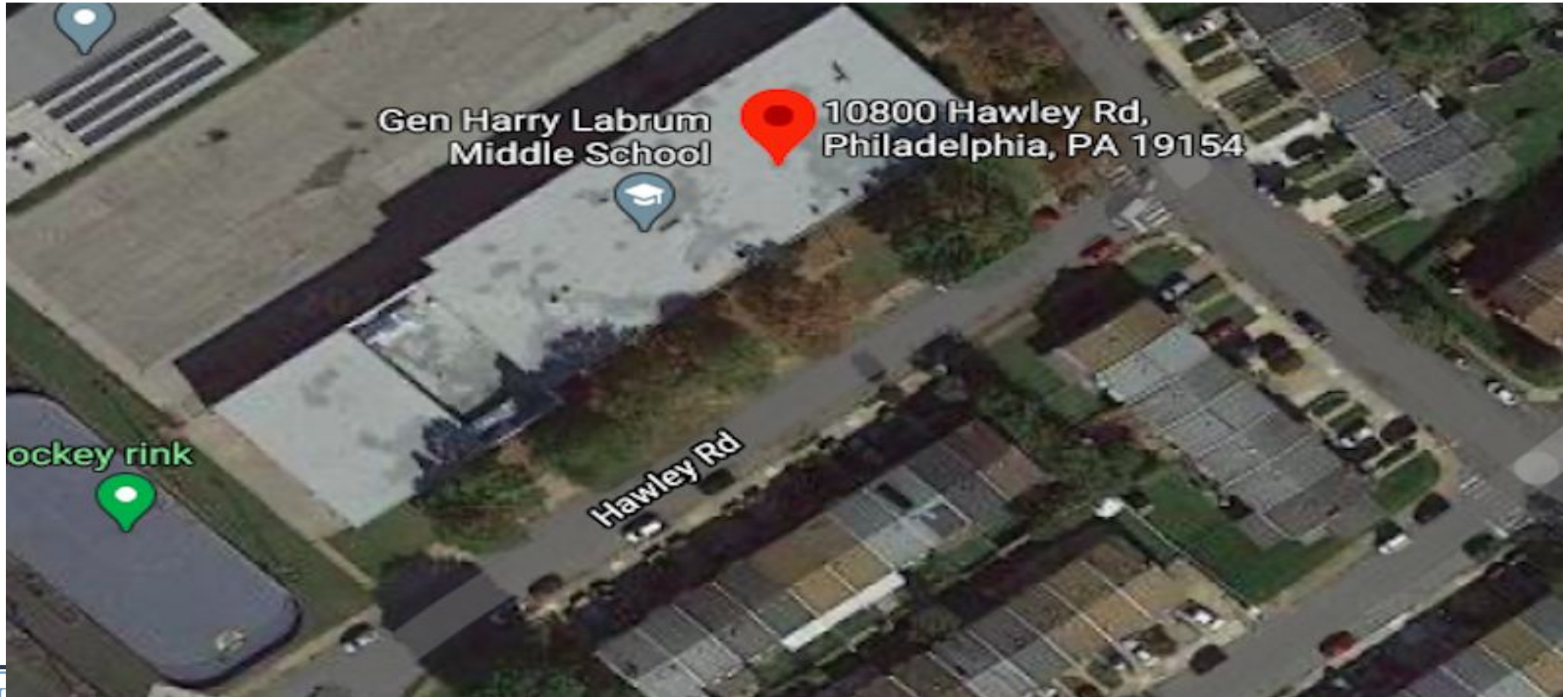


# Car Riders/Walkers - Enter/exit in front of the building

# Routine COVID Testing

- Any student who will be participating in hybrid learning must have parent consent completed for the routine COVID-19 testing.
- Students who do not submit parent consent for testing WILL NOT be permitted to participate in hybrid learning.

# Breakfast, Lunch, & Recess

- Students will eat breakfast in their classrooms.
- Students will eat lunch in the cafeteria.
- All students will have recess.
- Recess will be held outside - weather permitting.
- Students will be separated by section.
- Social distancing will be followed.



# Uniforms

**Students may wear either their regular uniform or their Gym uniform each day.**

- **Student Tops**

- Grades 6-8 students must wear Navy blue collared polo shirts.
- LaBrum is moving towards all students wearing Navy blue shirts.
- For the 20-21 school year, Grade 7 students are still permitted to wear light blue (powder blue) collared shirts. For the 20-21 school year, Grade 8 students are still permitted to wear white collared shirts.
- Students also have the option of wearing a plain navy Hancock or LaBrum School t-shirt or LaBrum Gear t-shirt. **NO OTHER Hancock/LaBrum t-shirts are permitted.**
- When cold in the classroom, students may wear SOLID black, blue, white, or gray sweaters, fleeces, or crew neck sweatshirts over their uniform shirts. These items cannot have any writing or stripes on them. Logos smaller than 1.5 inches are okay.
- LaBrum hoodies can be worn if hoodie passes are earned by students (schoolwide weekly incentive based on attendance & behavior).

- **Student Bottoms**

- Students are to wear khaki (tan) bottoms.
- Shorts must fall to the knee.
- No jeans.
- No logos on the clothing are allowed with the exception of Hancock/LaBrum School Logo clothing.

- **Student Footwear:** Footwear may be shoes or sneakers. No open-toe shoes. No slip-on shoes without a full back.

- **Gym:** Grades 6-8 Students are to wear a navy gym shirt with SOLID navy, black, or gray sweatpants or leggings. Bottoms may not have stripes, be marbled, or mixed colors. Students must wear sneakers for gym.

- **Additional Uniform Information**

- Jewelry is discouraged.
- Jackets must be kept in lockers and are not permitted to be worn in the classroom.

# Masks are required for everybody.

- Students will attend school 2 days/week
  - Cohort A: Monday/Tuesday
  - Cohort B: Thursday/Friday
- Wednesday will remain virtual with synchronous learning in the AM and asynchronous learning in the PM.
